Lenore Portante enlisted in the Army Dec 1979 as an Intelligence Analyst. She attended military schools in Monterey, CA and Goodfellow AFB, TX before her 1st assignment at Ft Stewart, GA. Assigned to Field Station Berlin and Ft Hood TX before attending Officer Candidate School at Ft Benning, GA in Oct 1987.

Her officer assignments included Ft Hood, TX; deployment to the Gulf War; V Corps in Heidelberg, Germany; and Ft Irwin, CA where she retired as a Captain in Dec 1999.

Lenore's family moved to Scottsdale in Apr 2000, and she was hired by HonorHealth in 2006. She became the 1st full time employee of the Military Partnership in 2008.

The HonorHealth Military Partnership Program began in 2004 and since then, the program has trained more than 3,000 soldiers and airmen in trauma and deployment skills at the 7,500 square foot training center on the HonorHealth Scottsdale Osborn Medical Center campus. All branches of the military, active duty, National Guard and Reserves may participate including Scottsdale and Phoenix Fire Departments.

Clinical rotations are customized, hands-on experiences that enable military personnel to practice needed skills, particularly in preparation for deployment.
